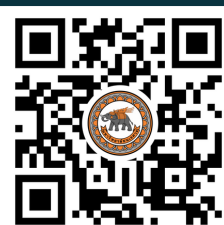

### Application:

Applications must be submitted to International Office of your university. Each university may nominate up to two participants to Naresuan University. (Division of International Affairs and Language Development).



### Requirements:

Applicants must be

- a bachelor's degree student
- enrolled as a full-time student at his/her home university during the exchange period
- able to communicate in English
- interested in learning Thai culture
- excellent in interpersonal skills



### Required Application Documents:

- NU Application Form
- A Nomination Letter from your university's International Office or Dean, endorsing all applying students for the participation in this exchange program.
- A Statement of Purpose
- A Valid Passport (can be submitted after nomination)
- A Full Coverage Overseas Travel Insurance (can be submitted after nomination)
