Did you know? For over 25 years, Canada's National Research Council and Taiwan's National Science and Technology Council have cooperated on research activities.

That's why Canadian non-profit national research organization, **Mitacs**, and the **National Applied Research Laboratories** of Taiwan (NARLabs) are proud to announce a new agreement to cultivate talent by creating opportunities **for international research collaboration** activities for students and postdoctoral fellows.

Mitacs and NARLabs collectively propose **two competitive programs to cultivate talent**

### Globalink Research Internship (全球鏈結研究實習)

- open to up to 30 senior undergraduate students (completed >2 years of study) in any discipline, at any Taiwanese university
- supports a 12-week research project on an area of the student's choice
- supervised by a professor in a Canadian host institution
- provides up to CA\$12,000 to cover round-trip travel to Canada, living allowances & insurance
- includes access to professional development training

### Globalink Research Award (全球鏈結研究獎學金)

- open to up to 30 graduate (Master's/PhD) students and postdoctoral fellows in any discipline, at practically all institutions in Taiwan
- awards up to CA\$6,000 to enable talented researchers to undertake 12- to 24-week projects in Canada

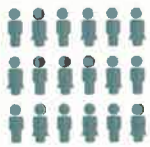

# STUDY IN CANADA SCHOLARSHIPS

**Scholarships** for students from Taiwan and other eligible countries/territories to pursue **study** or **research exchanges** in Canada at the college, undergraduate and graduate levels.



## Who is eligible?

- Students must be citizens of an eligible country/territory
  - Asia: Taiwan, Bangladesh, Nepal
- Students must be enrolled full-time at post-secondary institutions in the eligible country/territory



## How much can I receive?

- CA\$ 10,200 for college, undergraduate and graduate students for four months (or one academic term) of study / research
- CA\$ 12,700 for graduate students for a period of five to six months of study or research



## What does it cover?

- Visa or study / work permit fees
- Round trip airfare to Canada
- Health insurance
- Living expenses
- ... and more!



## Who can apply?

- A Canadian institution must apply **on behalf of** an eligible international student

## Application Deadline

- Competition generally opens in January
- Deadline generally falls in mid-March for Canadian institutions to submit applications on behalf of students

## HOW DOES IT WORK?



- 1 Ask your school's international affairs office about Study in Canada Scholarships



- 2 Make sure you meet the Canadian partner institution's eligibility and admission requirements and application process



- 3 Your institution contacts the Canadian partner, who applies for the Scholarship on your behalf



- 4 Receive funds - travel to Canada, study and have fun!



- 5 Return to your home institution in Taiwan to complete your program
